



NannyTap Wedding Childcare Baby Cam Policy

At NannyTap, we value transparency and the comfort of both our clients and our professional caregivers. To ensure the lawful and appropriate use of baby cams during our wedding childcare services, we have established the following policy. By agreeing to this policy, clients can monitor their children's well-being while respecting privacy laws and safeguarding our caregivers' dignity and rights.

1. Permissible Use of Baby Cams

Clients may use baby cameras (baby cams) to monitor the care and safety of their children during our childcare services under the following conditions:

- Baby cams must only be placed in approved areas, such as the main bedroom or sitting areas where childcare is provided.
- Recording must be disclosed to and acknowledged by NannyTap staff prior to the session, and caregivers must provide their written consent.
- The baby cam is solely for monitoring children's safety and care, and footage may not be shared publicly or used for any purpose outside personal viewing.

2. Prohibited Areas for Baby Cam Recording

To protect privacy, baby cams must not be installed or used in the following areas:

- Bathrooms or en-suite facilities, even if children are bathed or changed there.
- Hallways, closets, or other areas not explicitly designated for childcare.
- Any space where the caregiver is entitled to reasonable personal privacy.

3. Legal Compliance and Privacy

- Clients must ensure the use of baby cams complies with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and relevant privacy laws.
- Caregivers retain the right to refuse their services in any setting where they feel privacy or dignity is compromised by improper baby cam use.
- Recorded footage is considered personal data and must be handled with care. It must not be shared, published, or stored in a manner that breaches data protection laws.

4. Disclosure and Consent

- Clients are required to notify NannyTap in advance of their intention to use a baby cam.
- Caregivers must provide explicit, written consent to be recorded in the specified

area(s).

- Any undeclared or unauthorized use of baby cams is a breach of this policy and may result in termination of services.

5. Installation and Monitoring

- Baby cams must be securely installed to avoid accidents or interference with the caregiver's ability to perform their duties.
- Monitoring must be discreet and limited to times when children are under the caregiver's supervision.
- Cameras must not have audio recording capabilities unless explicitly agreed upon by both parties.

6. Breaches and Consequences

Failure to adhere to this policy may result in:

- Immediate termination of NannyTap services without refund.
- Potential legal action if recording violates privacy laws or caregiver consent.
- Reporting to appropriate authorities if misuse or unlawful recording is identified.
